

Dear Parents:

The Elizabethtown Child Care Center health policies require written instructions from a licensed health care provider each time he/she prescribes or recommends a medication for an enrolled child. There are only two exceptions. They are:

1. The licensed health provider's office may give instructions by telephone to the program staff. (361-9824 phone and fax)
2. For sunscreen, diaper creams, teething gel or fever- reducing medications, the program may use an order from a licensed health professional that provides instructions for adjustment of dose and method of administration to give the medication to any child in the program whose parents provide written consent for use of that medication.

Please have your physician sign the attached blanket permission slip to add to your child's file. It will be still be necessary to sign our medication log with amounts and specific times for administration of a fever reducer. Thank you.
